
How a Cyclone Cleans Polluted Air



- Dirty (polluted) air from a factory enters the cyclone.
- The dirty air is swirled about in a mechanically-generated wind.
- Inertia causes the pollutant particles to leave the circular path of the wind, collect against the wall of the cyclone, and fall into a collection hopper.
- Clean air is released from the cyclone system.
