Level	Earthquake Impact Description
I	People cannot feel it, but it can be measured with a seismograph.
II	People lying down outside may feel it.
III	People indoors feel it. Parked cars rock.
IV	Pictures and lamps swing. Dishes rattle.
V	Windows and dishes break. People sleeping wake up.
VI	Furniture moves. Chimneys crack.
VII	Poorly built homes are damaged. Church bells ring. Waves are seen on ponds.
VIII	Many buildings are damaged. Furniture is overturned.
IX	Most buildings are damaged. Underground pipes can break.
X	Some bridges are destroyed. Railroad tracks bend. There are landslides.
XI	Very few buildings survive. Underground pipes are damaged.
XII	Everything is destroyed.
