Scissors Safety Sheet

As part of our project, students will potentially be using scissors as a primary tool for project construction. Please read over these basic scissor safety guidelines before using scissors on projects.

- 1. Focus on the task at hand when using scissors.
- 2. Always cut in a direction in which the scissors are pointed away from your body.
- 3. Never engage in horseplay with scissors.
- 4. Use scissors for cutting only. Do NOT use them for scraping, prying, pounding, etc.
- 5. Always pass scissors handles first.
- 6. Never toss or throw scissors.
- 7. Never walk around the room with scissors always put them down when getting up from any workstation.
- 8. Always put your scissors in the appropriate receptacle when not using them.
- 9. Regularly make sure scissors are clean so that they require less force to use.
- 10. If your scissors do not function properly, or you injure yourself, please tell the adult in your classroom immediately.
